ORDER

The detailed Order has been issued under the powers conferred under Section 22 of the Disaster Management Act 2005, imposing restrictions on various activities vide order No. HFW 90 ACS 2021 DATED 2/4/2021. In the order, in clause 6 Gyms were ordered to be closed. A number of representations were received by the Hon'ble Chief Minister to relax this restriction with certain conditions. It is now decided to modify this clause relating to Gyms.

Gyms will be allowed to remain open with the condition that

- The occupancy at any time cannot exceed 50% of the capacity.
- Strict COVID appropriate behaviour like ensuring wearing of masks, physical distancing, and provision of hand sanitiser shall be enforced.
- The equipment shall be sanitised after every use.
- If there is any violation, the Gym shall be closed till the COVID pandemic is over.
