ORDER

Sub: Regulation of movement of persons from other States to Karnataka.

Whereas, to combat the spread of COVID 19, the State Government has issued SOP for movement of persons from other State to Karnataka vide Order No RD. 158 TNR 2020 (P1), dated:03.06.2020. Subsequently, revised SOP was issued by the Department Health and Family Welfare Department vide document No. SOP4/IST/2, dated:08.06.2020. Further, quarantine norms were partially modified vide Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated:15.06.2020.

The quarantine surveillance has further been augmented through application of technology and increase in number of surveillance team. In light of the above, the quarantine norms issued vide Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated:15.06.2020, has been further modified and is as follows:

Quarantine Norms:

- a. Persons coming from Maharashtra shall be placed in 7-day institutional quarantine followed by 7-day home quarantine.
- b. Persons coming from State other than Maharashtra shall be placed in 14-day home quarantine.**

The other conditions specified in the Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated:15.06.2020 shall continue be in force until further orders.
